- Conduct themselves in a way that is consistent with the expectations that are held for students and inline with Woodline's Philosophy, Guiding Principles, Policies, Procedures & Child Safety Code of Conduct
- Commit to ongoing personal and professional development that enhances the effectiveness of the Woodline Philosophy and Guiding Principles and maintains current legislative requirements in relation to mandatory reporting and other Child Safe Standards requirements
- Act or Seek Advice or Report on all cases of suspected child abuse to comply with Duty of Care obligations
